Big Spring Park update

The board reviewed elevation map of Big Spring Park and discussed several options as noted by CMW. 1st board was in agreement that they would prefer to keep bathrooms in the new pavilion area near playground and explore options on the cost to install pump. Motion was made by C. Stoudt to ask the Versailles City Council to consider making Park Street a one-way street with the preference of the board that the street run North -South from library to Rose Hill, 2nd D. Gill All voted in favor of the motion.

Big Spring tree and invasive work

Rich informed board the work would continue this week with spraying of invasive plants and forestry mulching the downed trees at Big Spring Park

Huntertown Archeological Survey

Rich and Sioux informed the board that the state has determined that before we can receive the \$125,000 Land and Water grant funds, we must conduct an archeological survey. The cost of the survey is \$7,500 and the Fiscal Court and City Council have agreed to pay this cost.

Outdoor pool report

It's leaking again. 3rd year in a row and this makes 9th year out of 21 openings.

July Board meeting
