Approval of Minutes

Motion to approve May minutes S. Finney – 2nd K. O'Reel – All voted in favor.

Funding for Huntertown Pavilion Project

Rich and Sioux revealed the winning bid of \$686,900 by BCD, Inc. Sioux then explained the funding requests of the City and County. Rich recommended that the Parks Department contribute \$50,000 from our reserves to the project. He explained that we have plenty of reserves and that amount will be growing as the year end forecast will show later in the meeting. Motion to approve spending up to \$50,000 on the Huntertown Pavilion Project D. Gill, 2nd by D. Lodmell, all members voted in favor. S. Finney abstained from the vote.

Turf & lighting Project update.

Rich informed the board that the lights and final work around ball fields should be completed this week except for the replacement of a new light pole on field 7. Once the pole arrives electrician will be back on site to remove old pole and install new pole and lights. The field is currently open for play.

Formation of airfield relocation committee

Rich asked if board members would be willing to form a committee to meet with Tony Hardin so he could further explain the goals of the model airplane club and need for relocation. Motion by A. Keith to form at least a 5-person committee with no less than three (3) Parks board members and two (2) members of the model airplane club to meet to discuss options to make a recommendation to the Fiscal Court regarding relocation of airfield. Members expressing interest to serve on committee are C. Stoudt, G. Watson, P. Pinkston and J. Gay.

2nd by T. Sparks – All members voted to approve.

Rich provided the board with an updated year-end financial forecast.
